

Discover the charm of **Anglesey Abbey**, a beautifully preserved country house nestled in lush Cambridgeshire gardens. With its elegant interiors, classical art collection and working 18th century watermill, the Abbey offers a captivating glimpse into England's past. It was built circa 1600 on the site of a dissolved priory and was later transformed by Lord Fairhaven into a Jacobean-style manor filled with rare books, clocks and antiques.





**The Wimpole Estate** is a grand National Trust treasure with over 3,000 acres of historic parkland, vibrant gardens and a majestic Georgian mansion.

Wander through elegant interiors including Soane's striking yellow drawing room and a hidden basement. Venture outside to explore gardens shaped by luminaries such as Capability Brown and Humphrey Repton.
